1. Introduction

When you visit our website, a-jolt.com (the “Website”), A JOLT, Lda. (“A JOLT”) may store cookies or similar tracking technologies on your device. This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, the types we use, their purposes, and how you can control them. 2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (such as a computer, tablet, or smartphone) that help websites remember information about your visit. Other tracking technologies, like pixels and web beacons, work similarly to cookies. These tools allow us to monitor and analyze activity on the Website, enhancing your experience by remembering preferences and gathering information on how you use the Website.

Cookies may be set by the website you are visiting (“first-party cookies”) or by third parties providing services through that website (“third-party cookies”).

3. Types of Cookies We Use

When you visit the Website, we may use the following types of cookies:

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These cookies are essential for the Website to function properly. They enable basic features like navigation, access to secure areas, and remembering form entries. Disabling these cookies may impact the functionality of the Website.
- **Performance Cookies:** Performance cookies collect anonymous information about how visitors use the Website, helping us measure traffic and analyze usage patterns. This data allows us to improve the Website’s performance and the user experience. For example, we may use Google Analytics to gather aggregated insights on how visitors interact with our content.
- **Functionality Cookies:** These cookies remember choices you make on the Website, such as your preferred language or region, to provide a more personalized experience. Disabling functionality cookies may reduce the Website’s customization options for you.
- **Targeting and Advertising Cookies:** Targeting cookies track your browsing habits to deliver relevant ads based on your interests and to limit the number of times you see an ad. These cookies may be set by us or third-party advertising networks. They also help measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.
- **Third-Party Cookies:** Certain third-party services, such as social media plugins, may set cookies on your device when you interact with them on the Website. These cookies are subject to the privacy policies of the respective third parties.
